WHAT

 - 2) To collect input from youth all over Douglas through outreach, surveys and community meeting;
 - 3) To produce a city-wide youth town hall, television show
 - 4) To hold monthly meetings and participate in retreats, training, travel experiences to build leadership skills and get involved.

WHY

- ◆ Expose youth to the operation of local government, to build leadership skill, to get youth involved in addressing youth related issues.

WHEN/WHERE

- ◆ The Mayor's Youth Council will meet monthly in a set location and will attend mandatory orientation and adhere to a planned itinerary for a one-year to four-year term.
